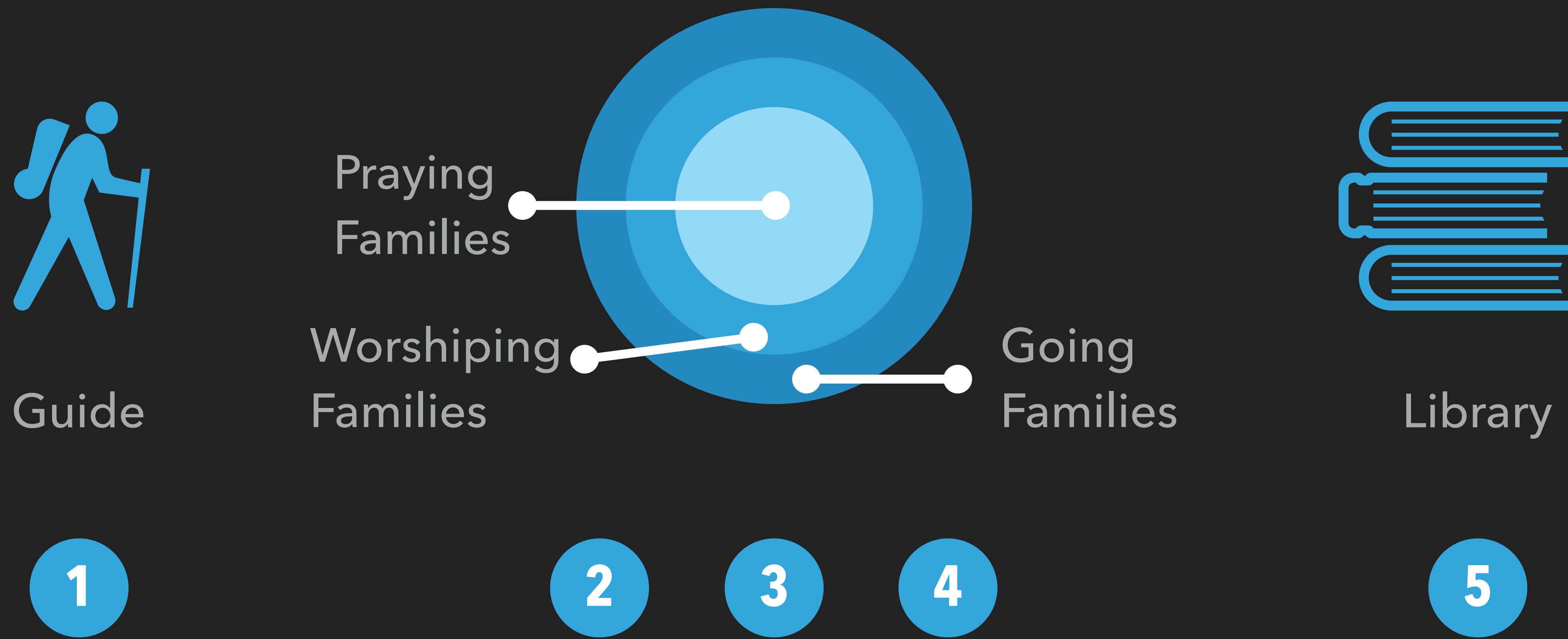

- ▶ Be an **ENCOURAGER**: Honey, not vinegar
- ▶ Be a **VISION CASTER**: For what family discipleship is
- ▶ Be an **EQUIPPER**: Resources and skills; be flexible
- ▶ Be a **CONNECTOR**: Pair as much as you can do on campus with the home
- ▶ Be a **TEACHER**: On how to share the gospel, what baptism is, what the Lord's Supper is, etc.
- ▶ Be a **REALIST**: Easier, reachable goals to grow from

PRAYING FAMILIES

- ▶ **SIMPLICITY** of prayer
 - ▶ Talking with God
 - ▶ Short and sweet, but not trite
 - ▶ Holy but joyous

PRAYING FAMILIES

- ▶ **RHYTHMS** of prayer

- ▶ Bedtime

- ▶ Morning

- ▶ Meals

- ▶ Car rides

PRAYING FAMILIES

- ▶ **METHODS** of prayer
 - ▶ Sentence prayers: "What's one thing you're thankful for?"
 - ▶ Summary prayers: "God, we give all we just talked about to you."
 - ▶ Popcorn prayers: "Describe God in one word."
 - ▶ A.C.T.S. prayers: Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication

WORSHIPING FAMILIES

- ▶ A **CADENCE** for Family Worship
 - ▶ 1x per week to start
 - ▶ Enough to build a rhythm, but not too much to be a burden (think gyms in February)
 - ▶ A time easiest to protect
 - ▶ During or right after a meal (dessert = God's Word is sweet)
 - ▶ 5 minutes to start

WORSHIPING FAMILIES

- ▶ A **MODEL** for Family Worship
 - ▶ Read and Pray (Sunday's passage; a short devotion)
 - ▶ Read, Ask, and Pray (discussion prompts)
 - ▶ Read, Discuss, and Pray (self-guided discussion)
 - ▶ Read, Discuss, Apply, and Pray (add living out what is learned)
 - ▶ Read & Summarize, Ask & Wonder, Oughtness & Jesus, Apply & Pray

WORSHIPING FAMILIES

- ▶ A **BUFFET OF OPTIONS** for Family Worship
 - ▶ Resource a suggested starting model as best as you can
 - ▶ Give a road map for expanding and growing the model
 - ▶ Provide other options: singing, activities, art, journaling
 - ▶ Give every family a tool belt (vision), and then as many tools they want to put in that tool belt to use
 - ▶ Not all families will disciple the same way; that's okay

GOING FAMILIES

- ▶ Going through **CULTURE-EVALUATING**
 - ▶ Where do we see Jesus (or lack of) and gospel connections?
 - ▶ Behavior and character of people in shows, movies, sports, etc.
 - ▶ World events and news
 - ▶ School
 - ▶ Connects the “academic” to real life
 - ▶ Help your families live in our culture without compromising to it

GOING FAMILIES

- ▶ Going through **DECISION-MAKING**
 - ▶ Do any of the 613 commands in Scripture speak to it
 - ▶ Those we must obey
 - ▶ Those we draw principles from (i.e., OT worship commands)
 - ▶ Is it sinful?
 - ▶ What decision most looks like Jesus?
 - ▶ Rest and move forward!

GOING FAMILIES

- ▶ Going through **SERVING OTHERS**
 - ▶ Discipleship drives toward serving
 - ▶ And serving helps make sense of discipleship
 - ▶ We learn most about love by loving
 - ▶ Connect with community organizations
 - ▶ Cast vision for being Christlike neighbors

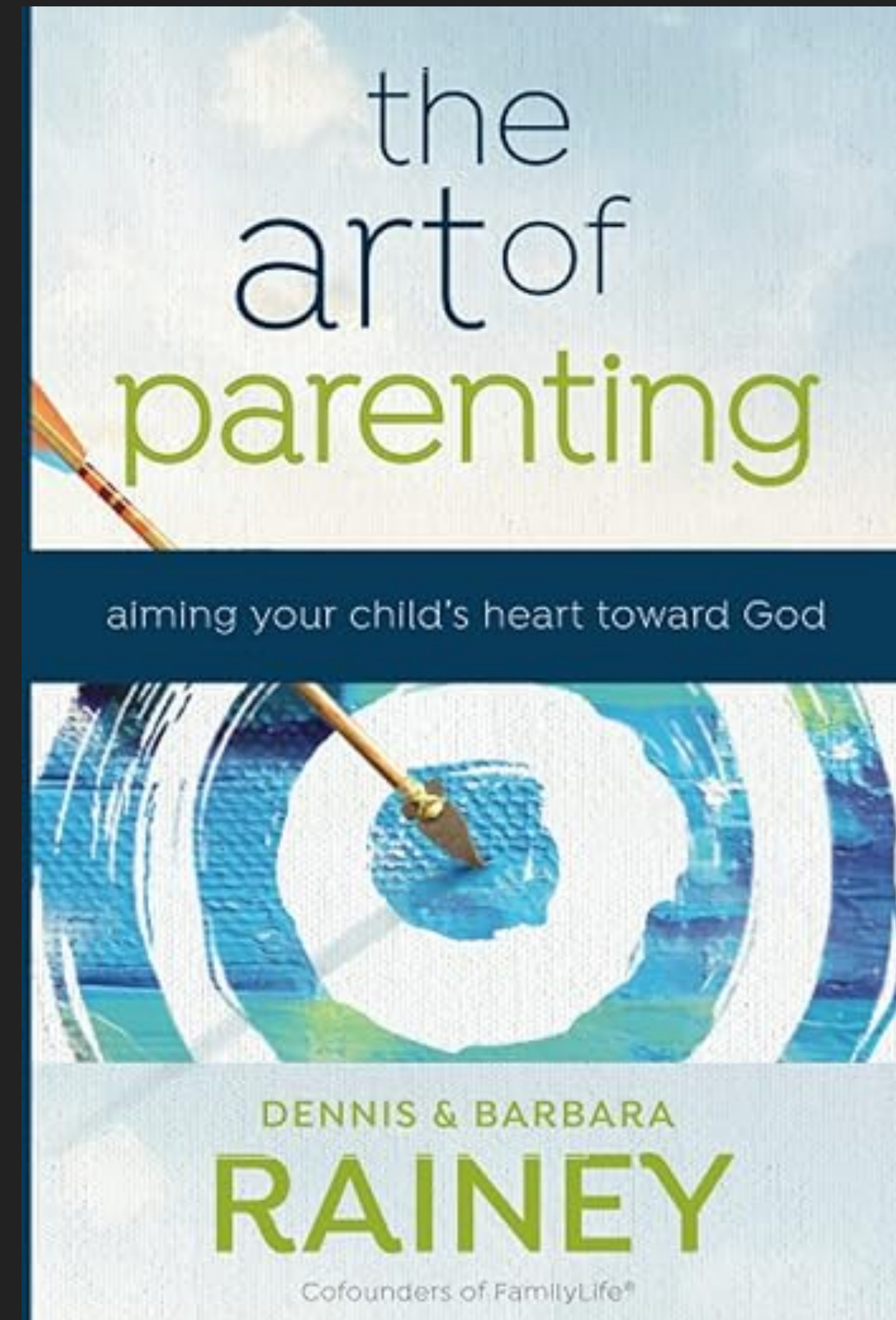

AIMING YOUR CHILD'S HEART TOWARD GOD

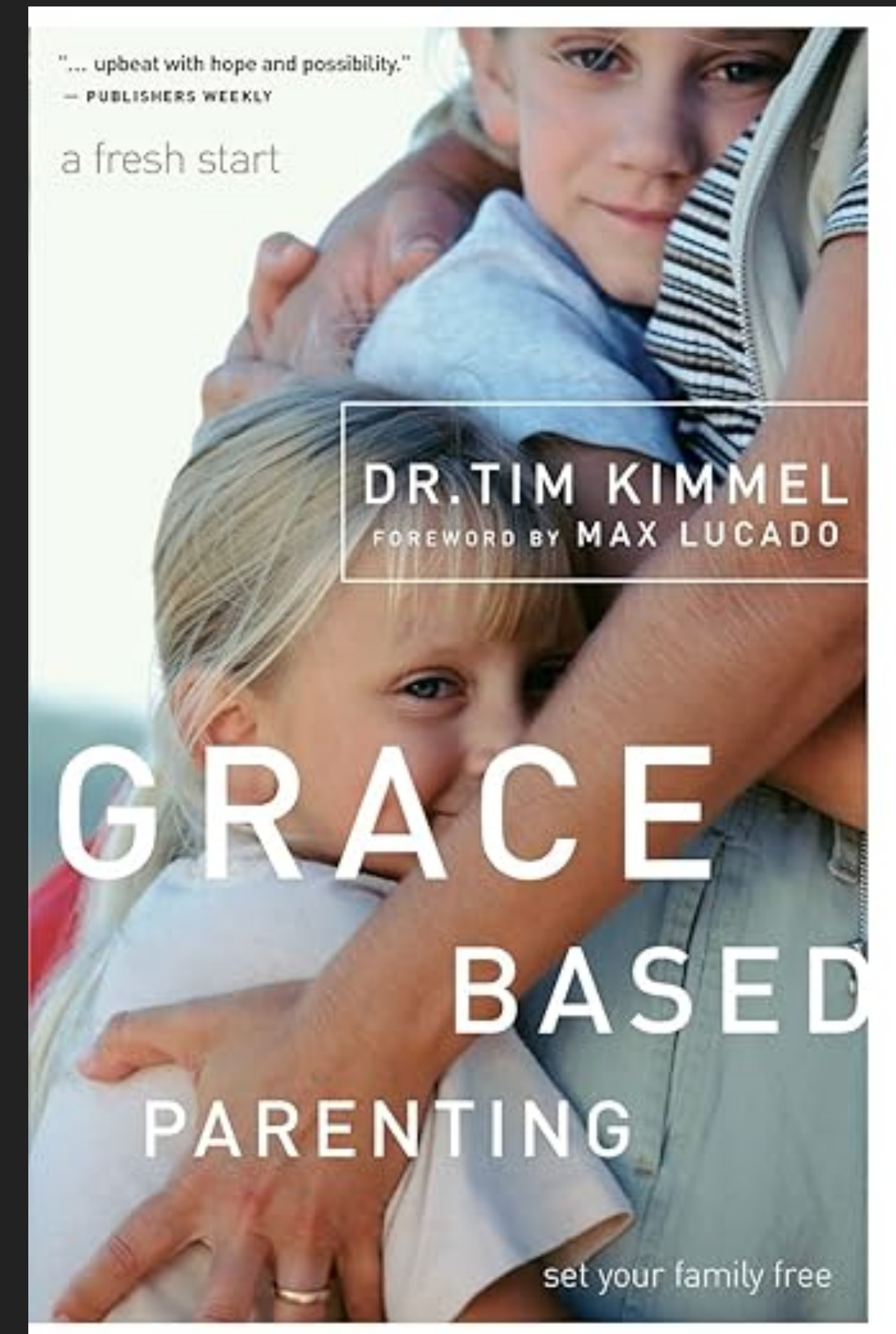
- ▶ **DENNIS & BARBARA RAINEY**

BABY – 12TH GRADER

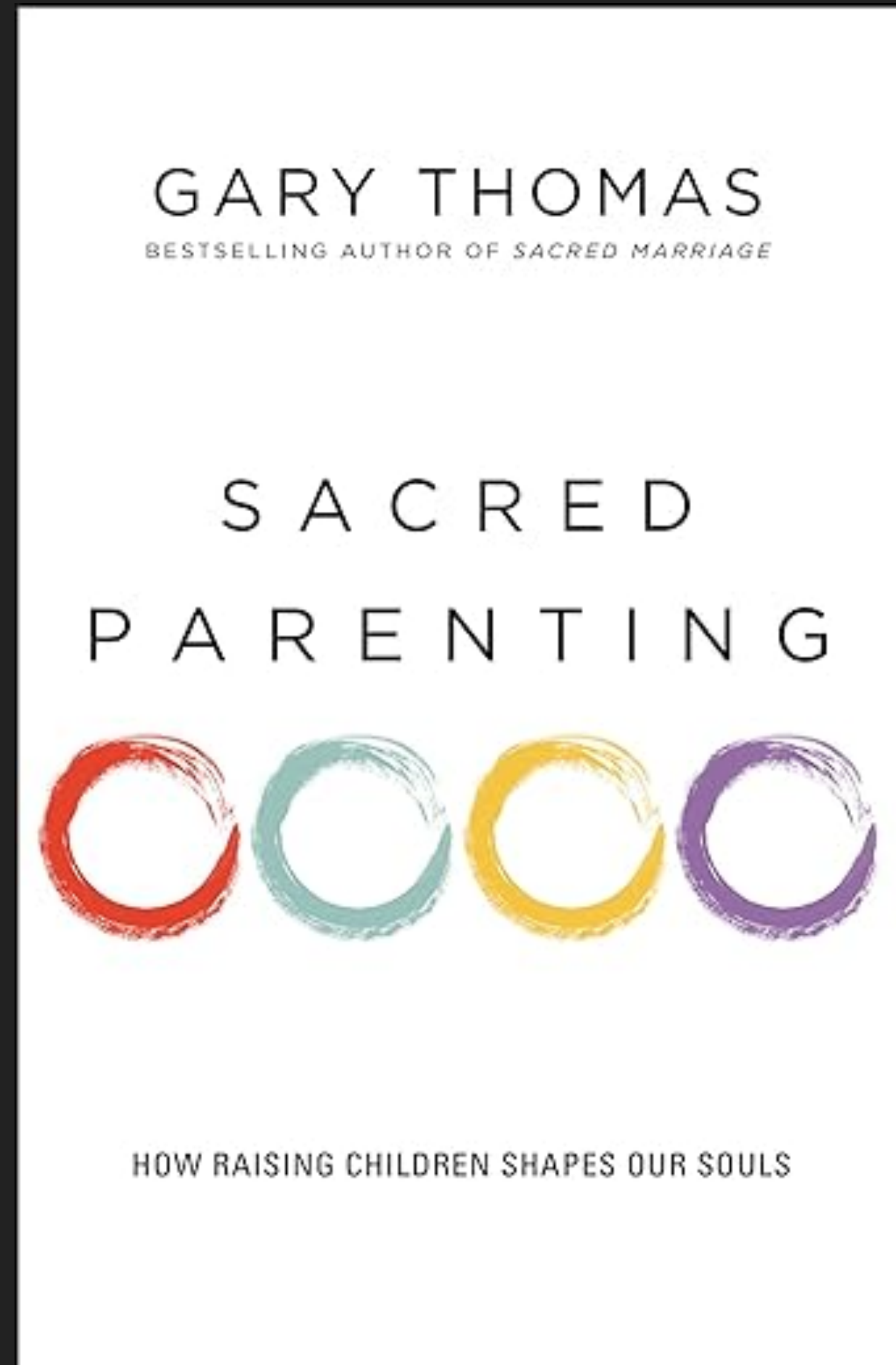
- ▶ **THINK ORANGE**

HOW RAISING CHILDREN SHAPES OUR SOULS

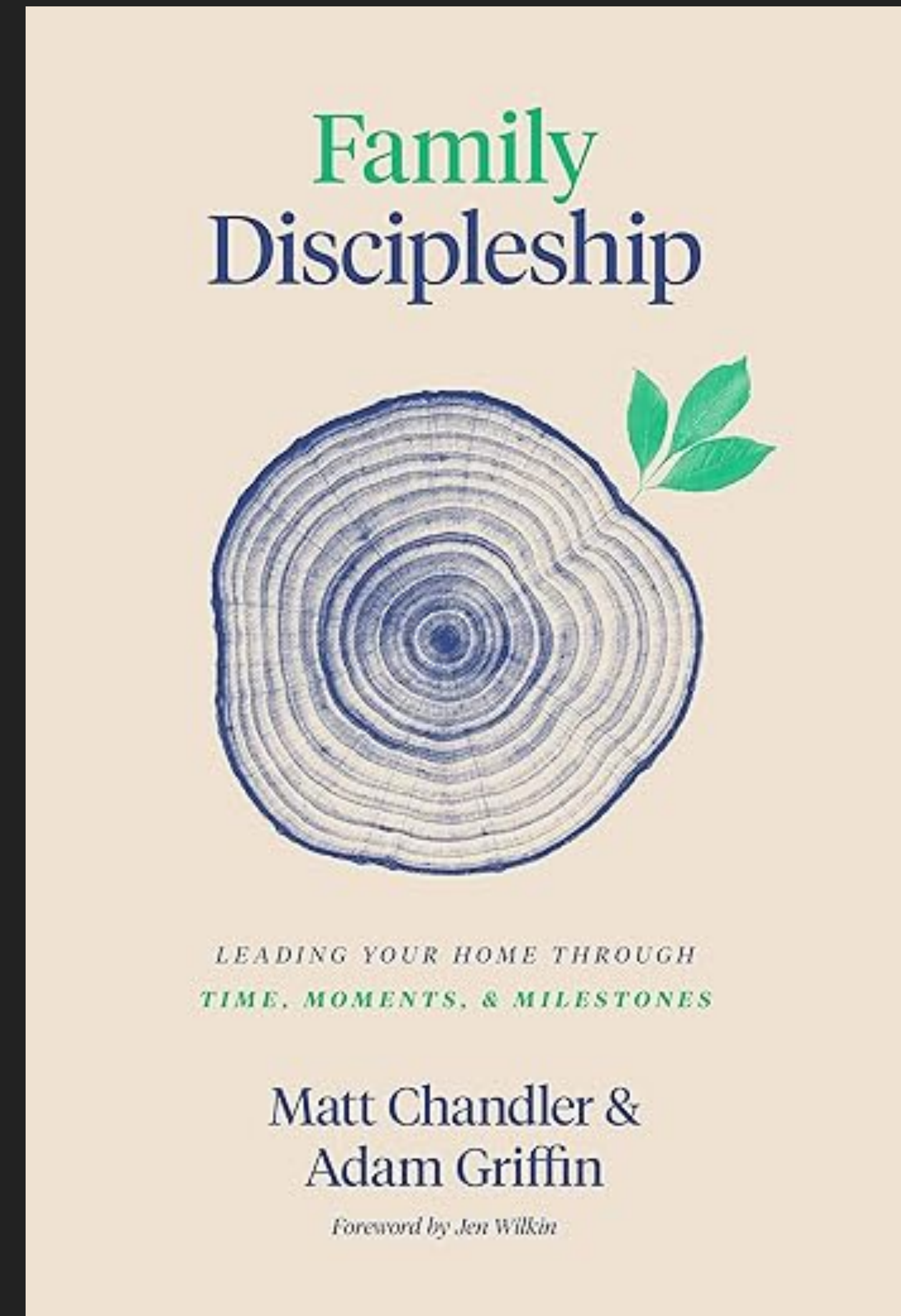
- ▶ **GARY THOMAS**

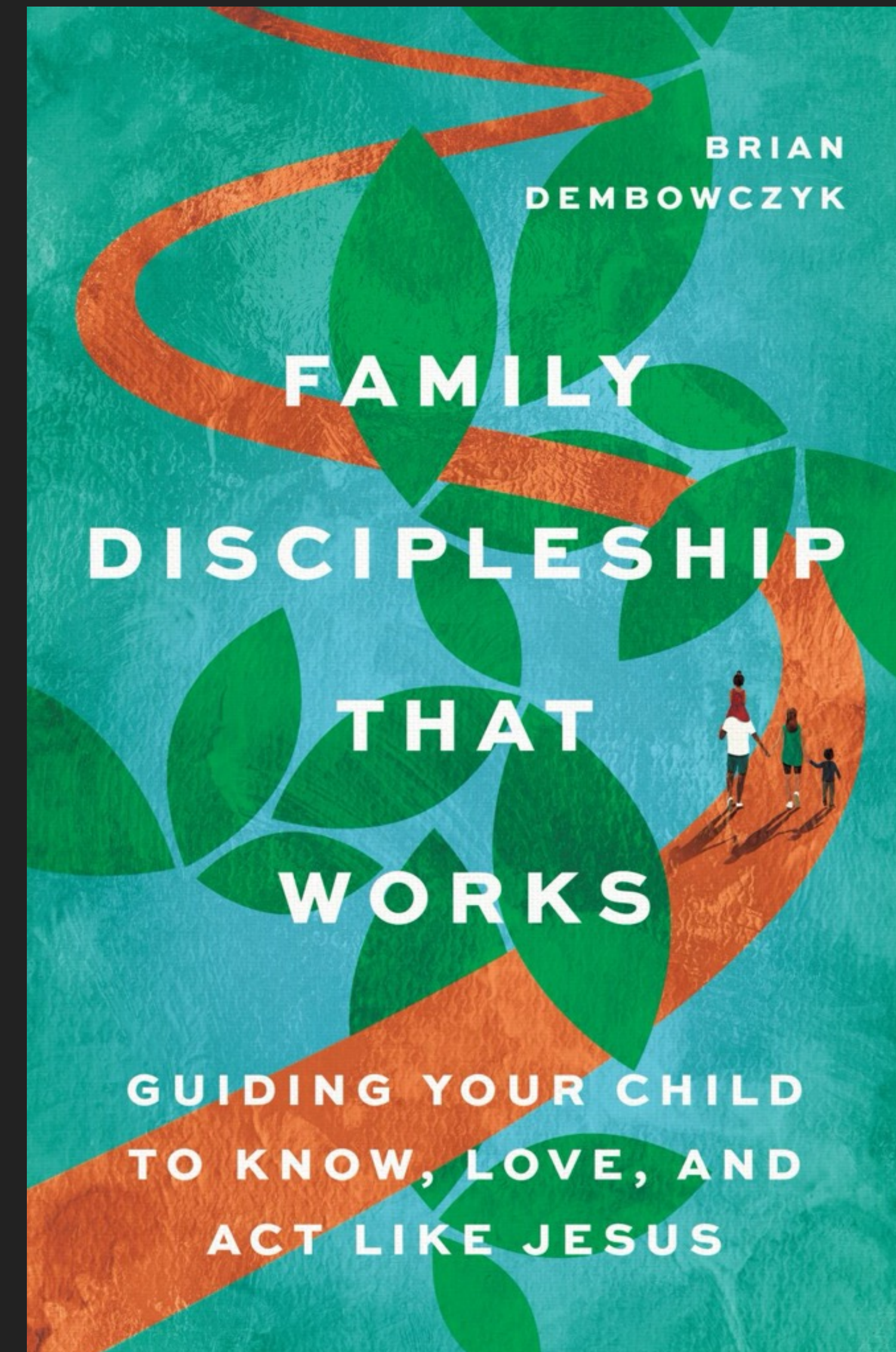
- ▶ **MATT CHANDLER & ADAM GRIFFIN**

GUIDING YOUR CHILD TO KNOW, LOVE, AND ACT LIKE JESUS

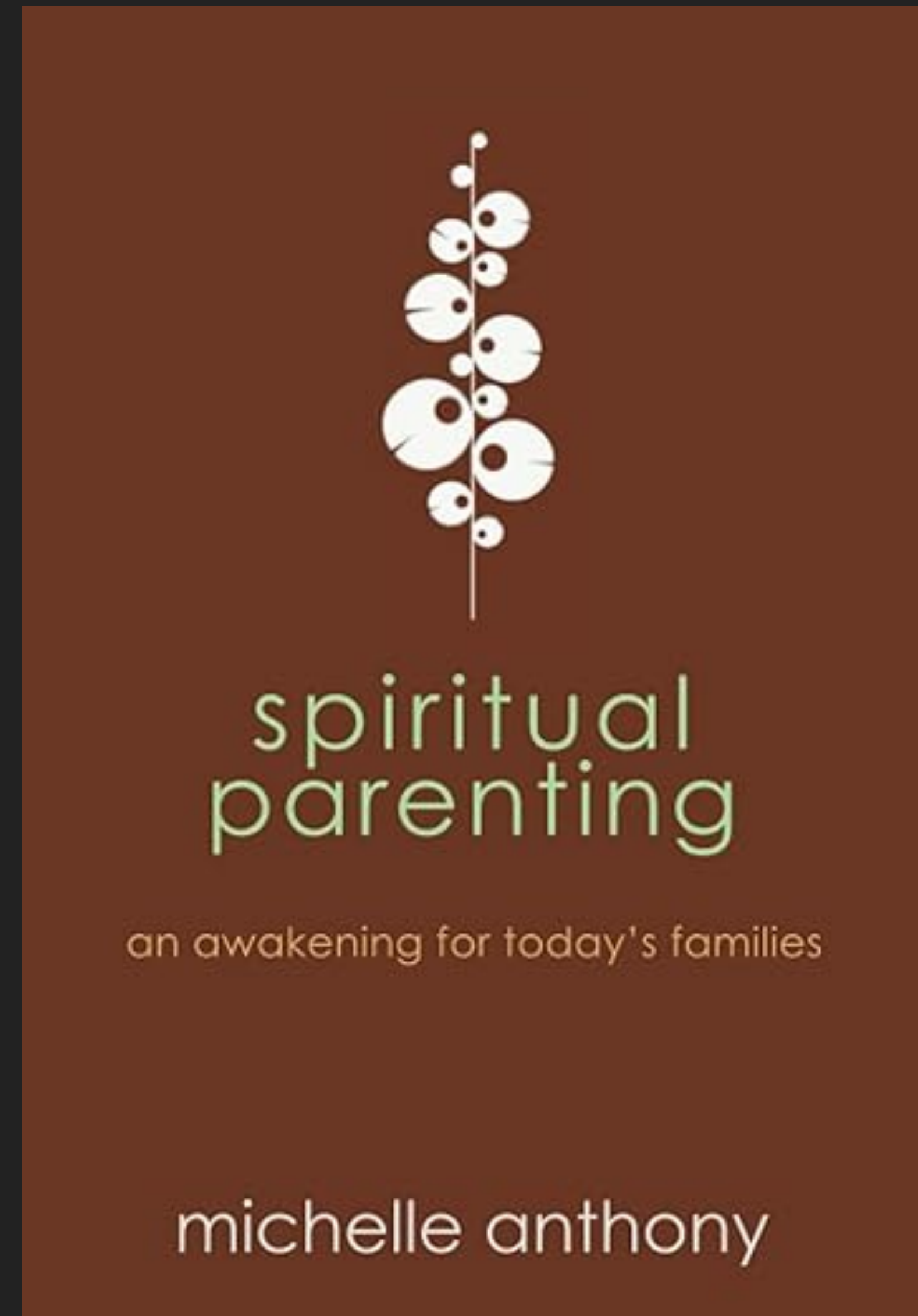
- ▶ **BRIAN DEMBOWCZYK**

AN AWAKENING FOR TODAY'S FAMILIES

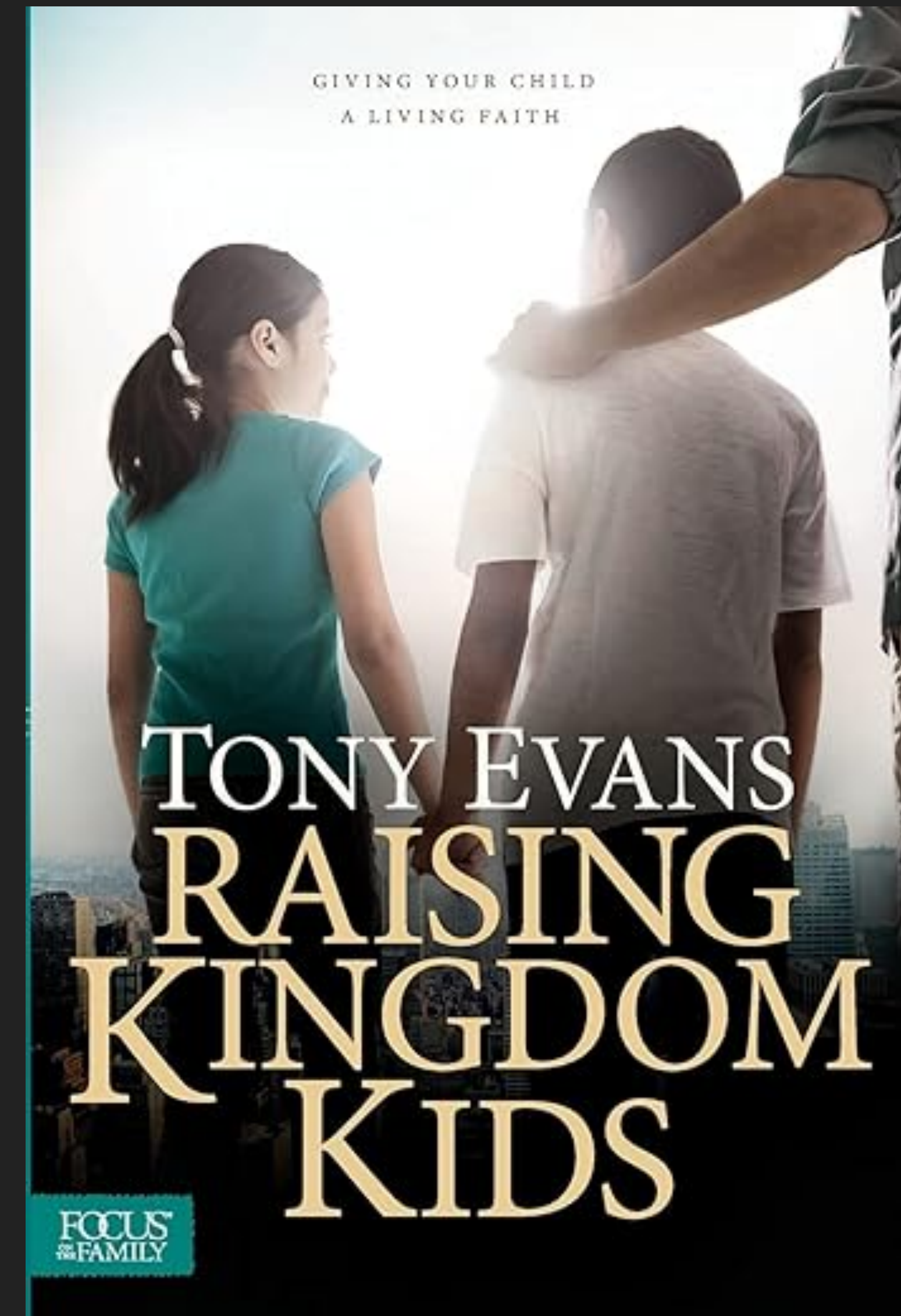
- ▶ **MICHELLE ANTHONY**

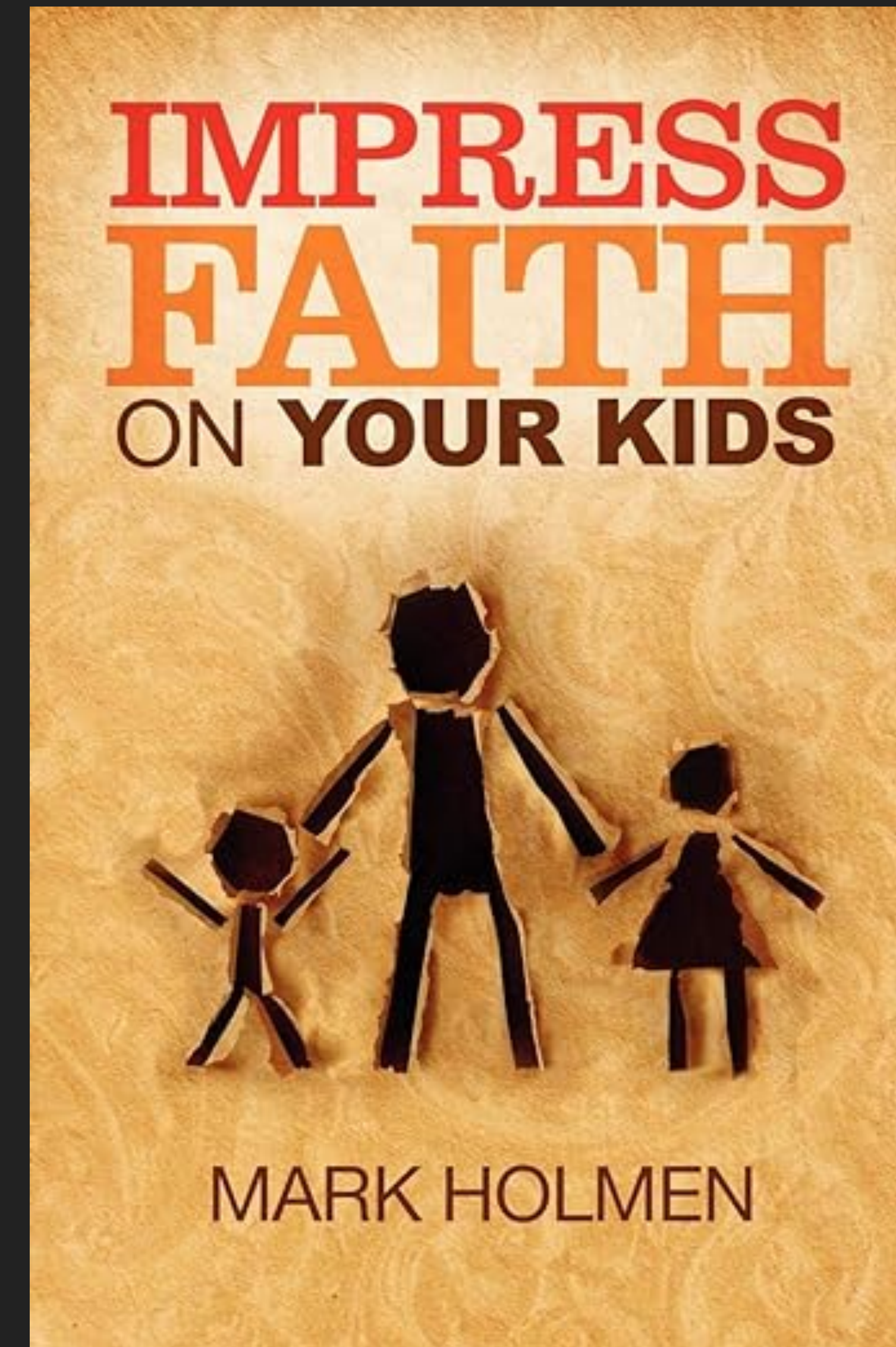
GIVING YOUR CHILD A LIVING FAITH

IMPRESS FAITH ON YOUR KIDS

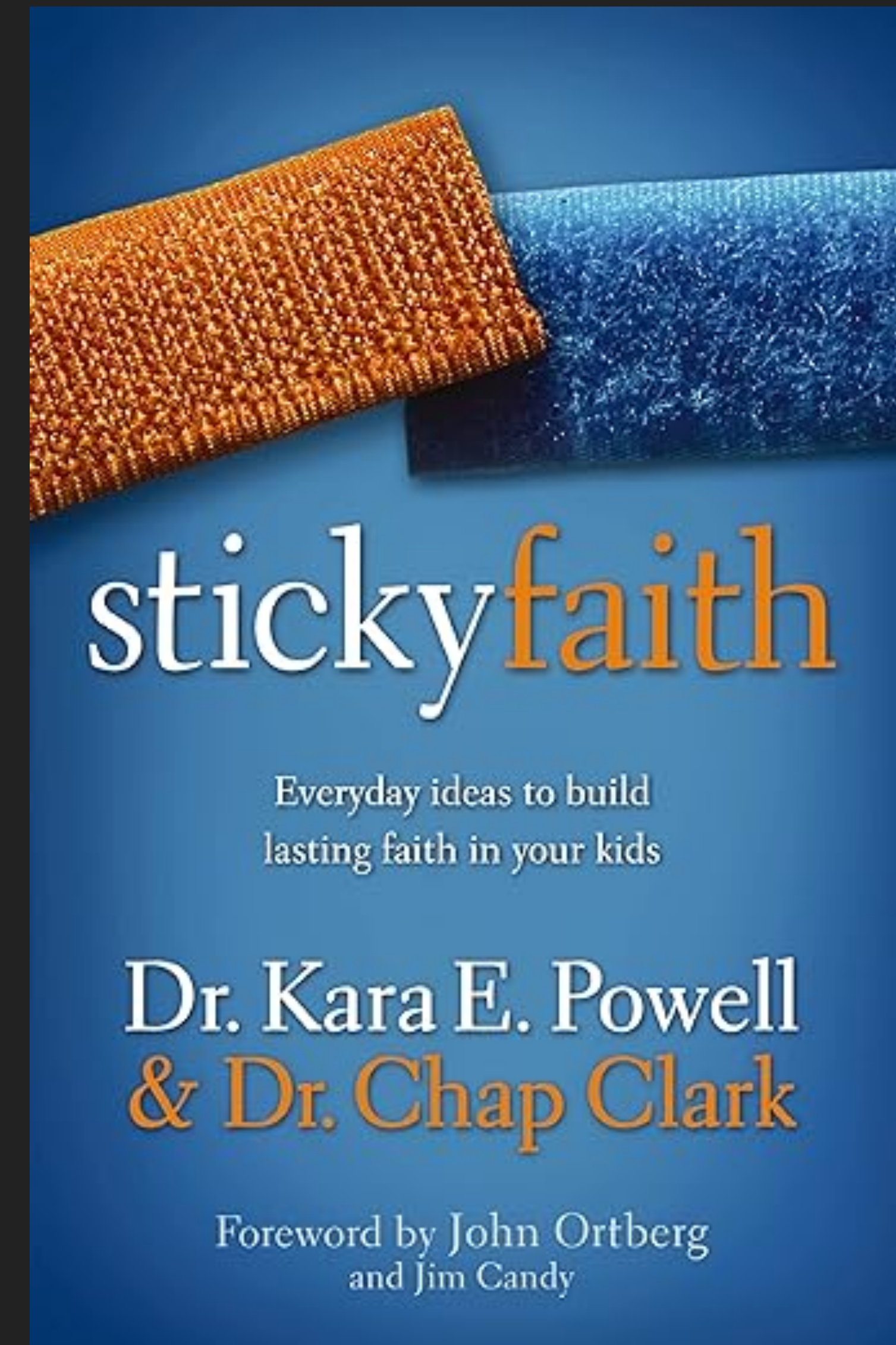
- ▶ **MARK HOLMEN**

EVERYDAY IDEAS TO BUILD LASTING FAITH IN YOUR KIDS

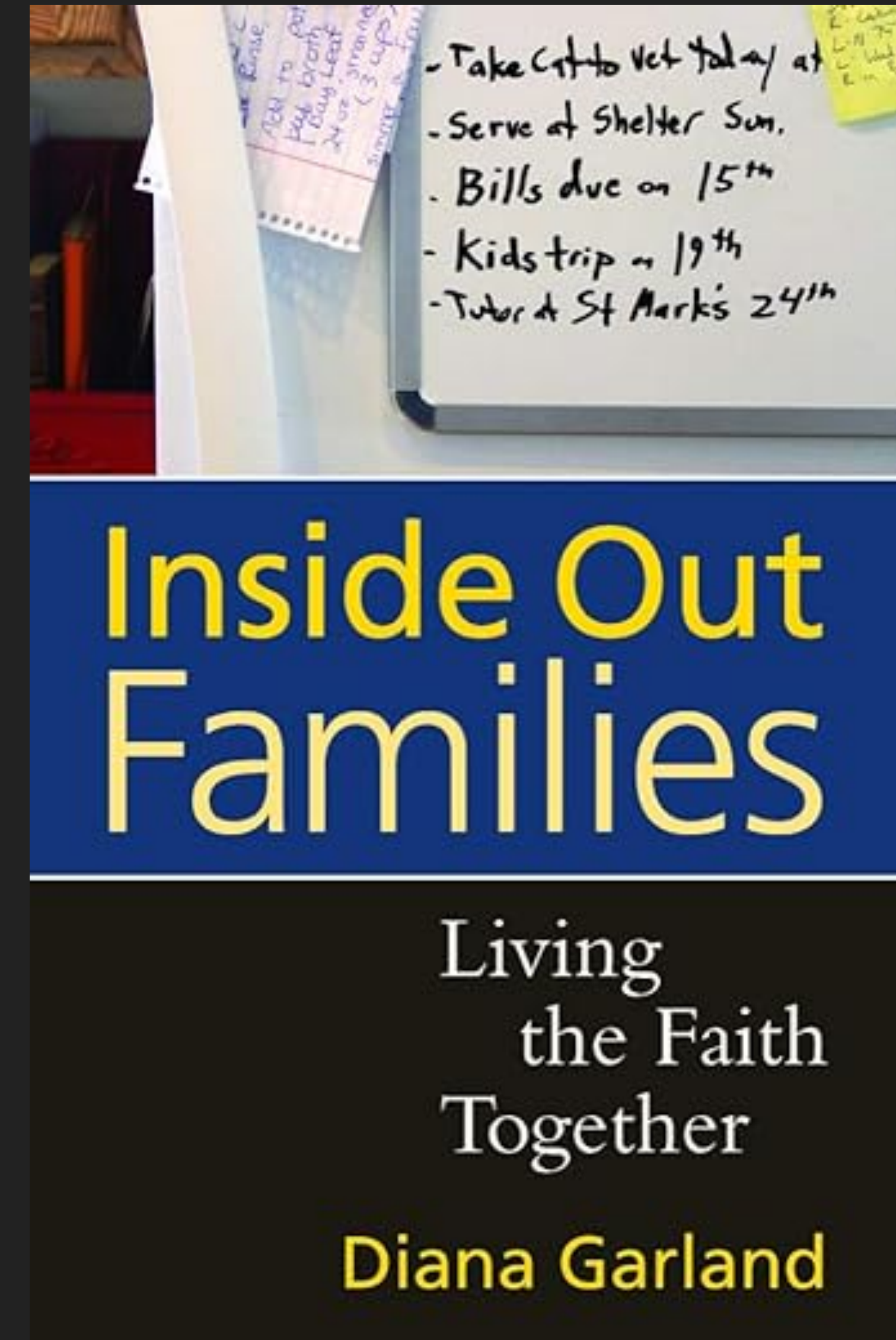
- ▶ **KARA POWELL & CHAP CLARK**

LIVING THE FAITH TOGETHER

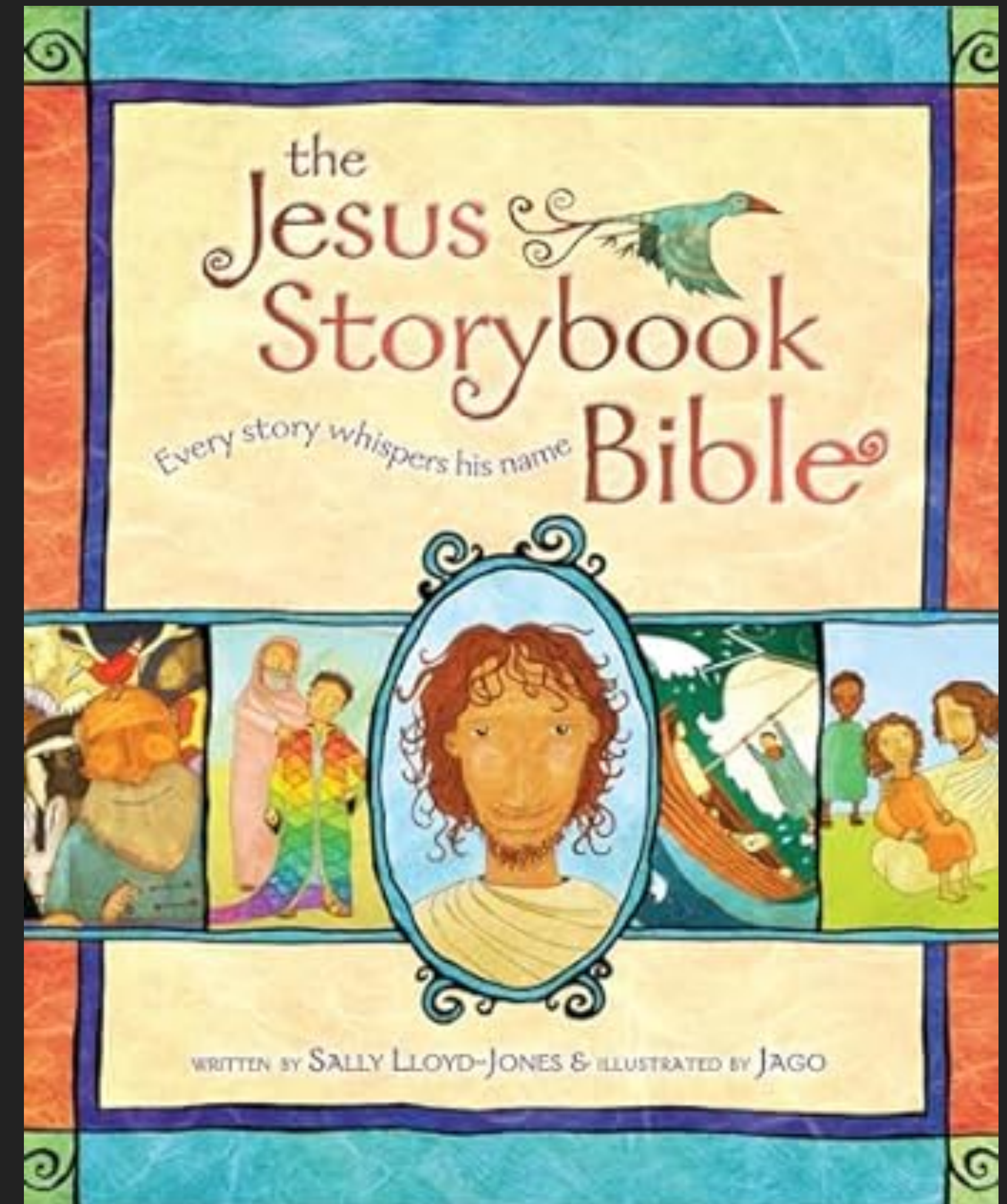
- ▶ **DIANA GARLAND**

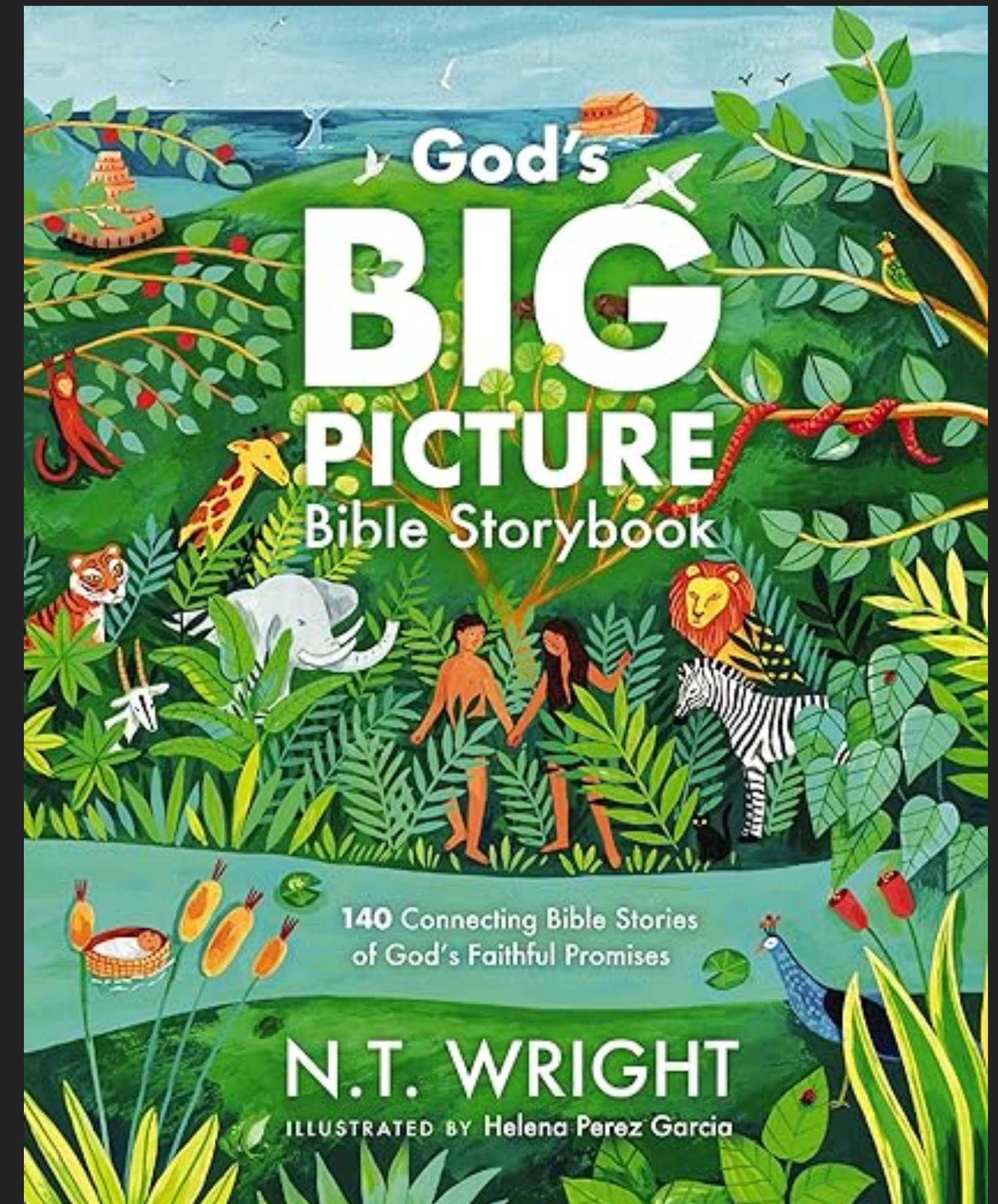

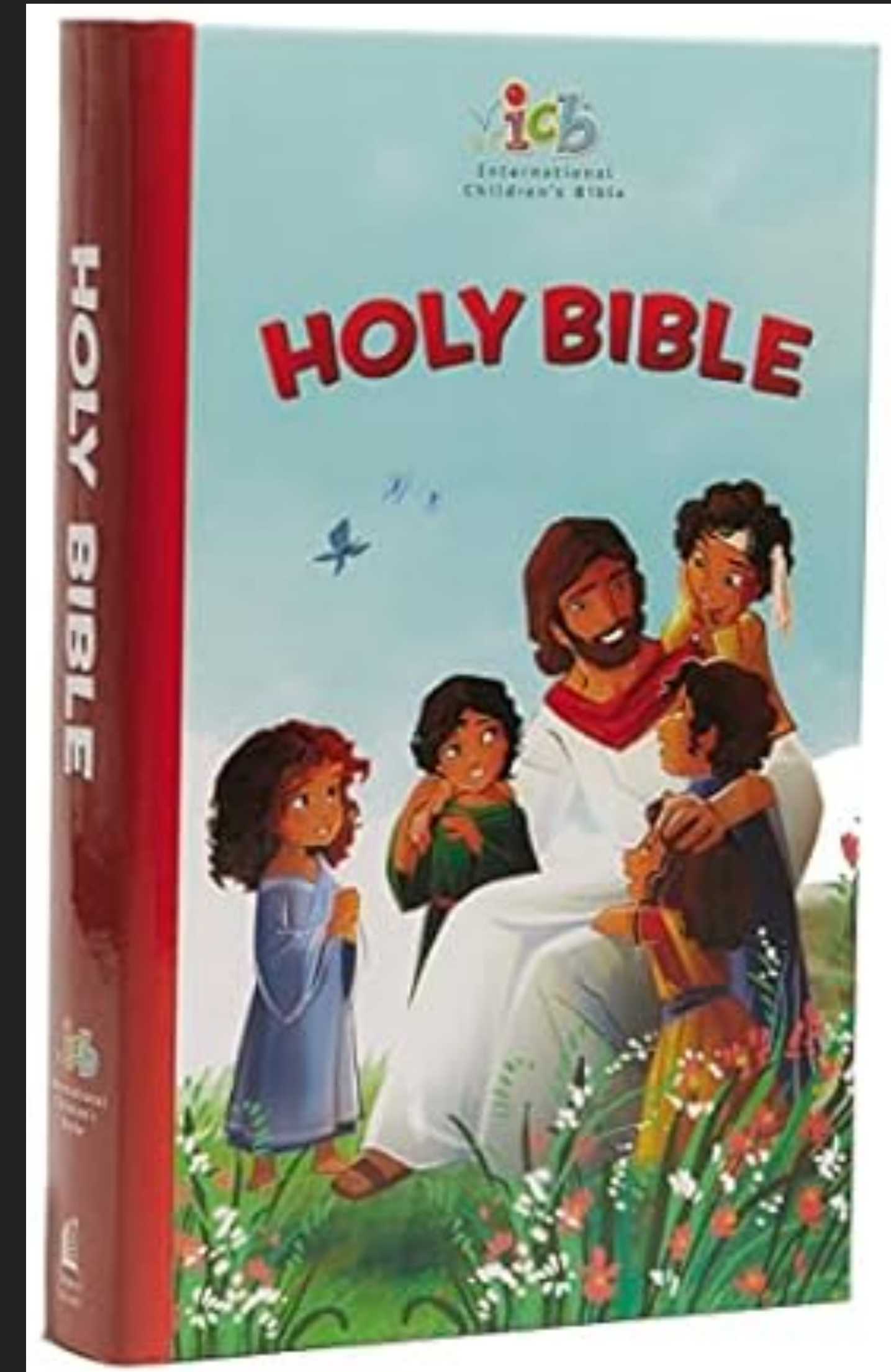

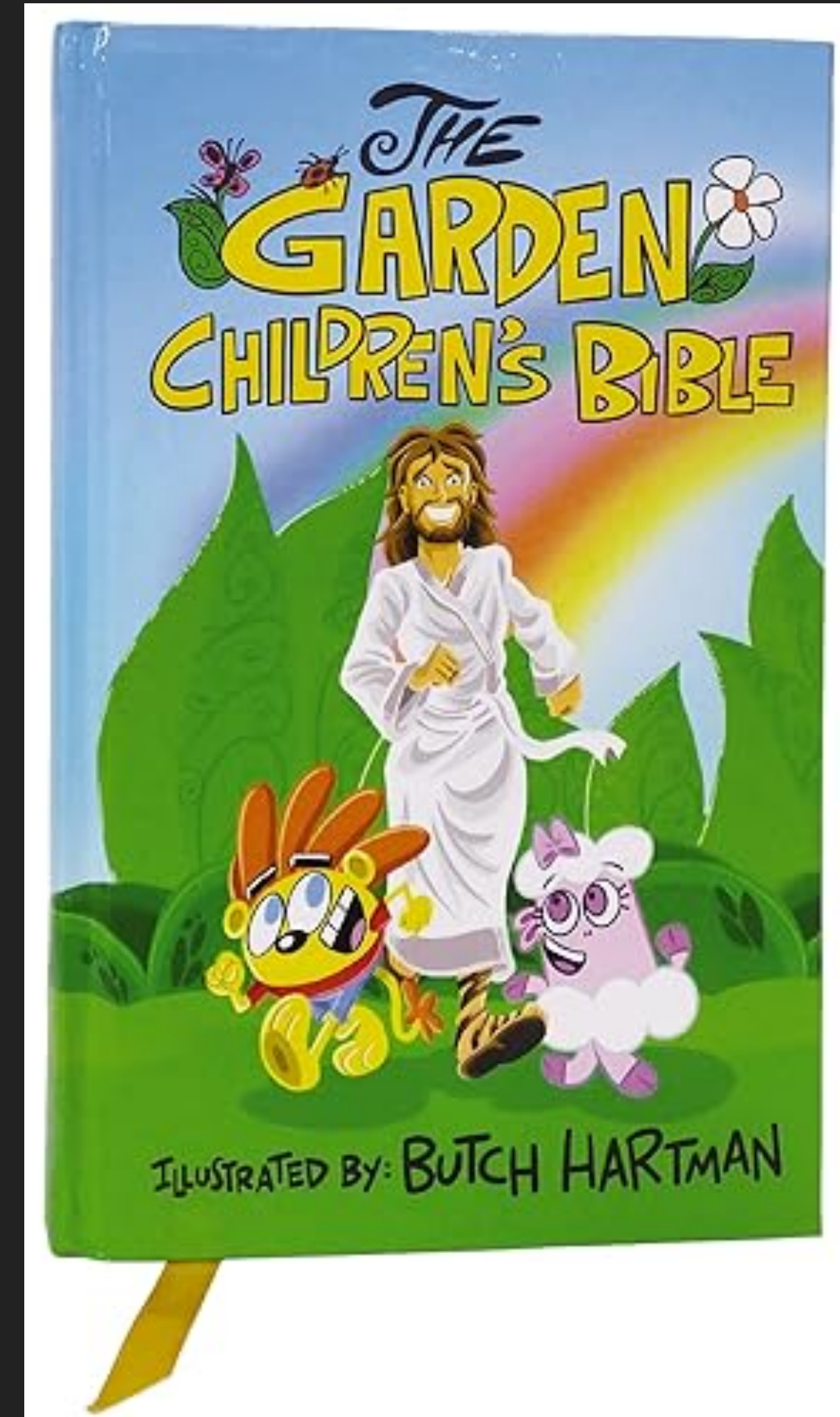

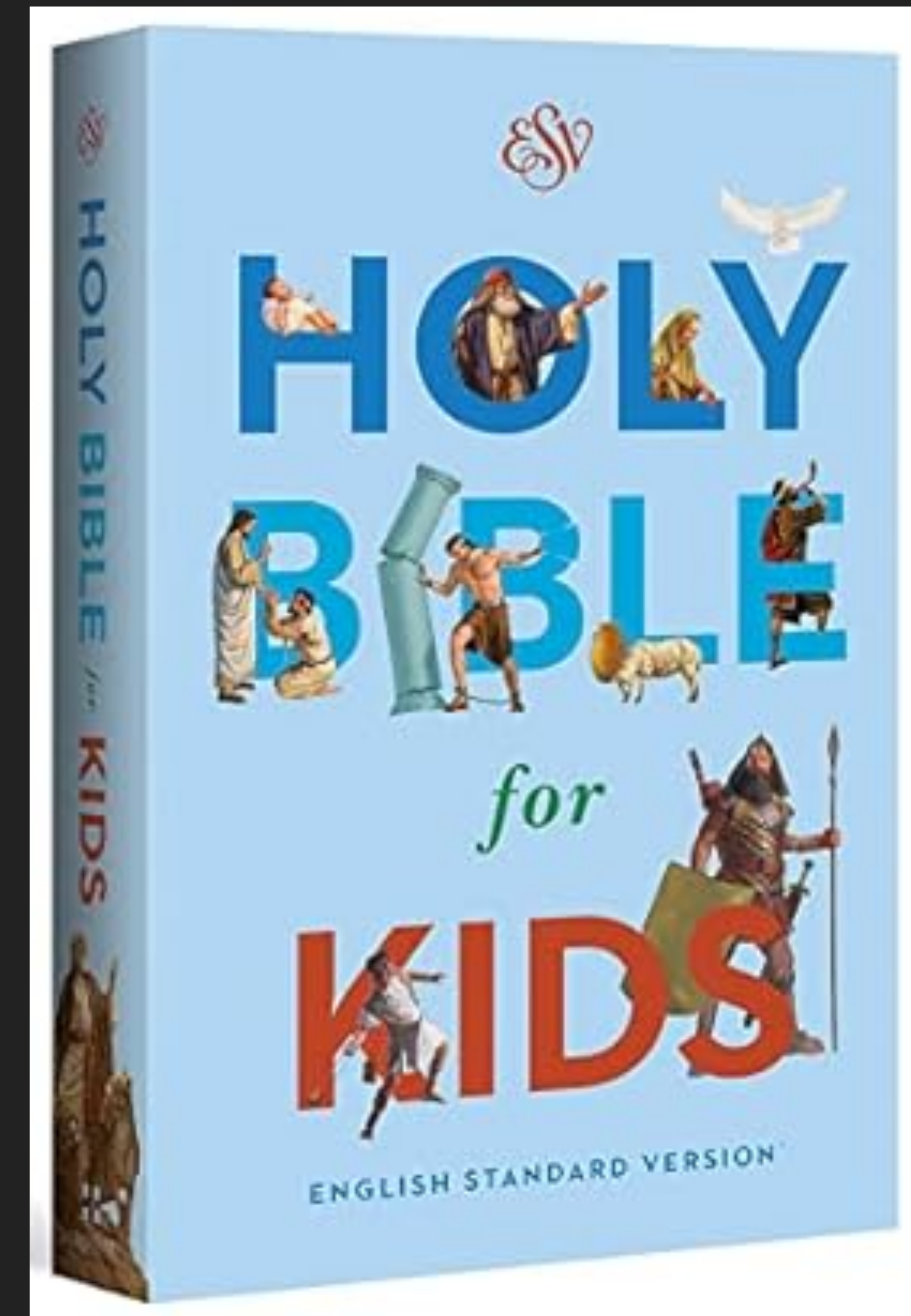

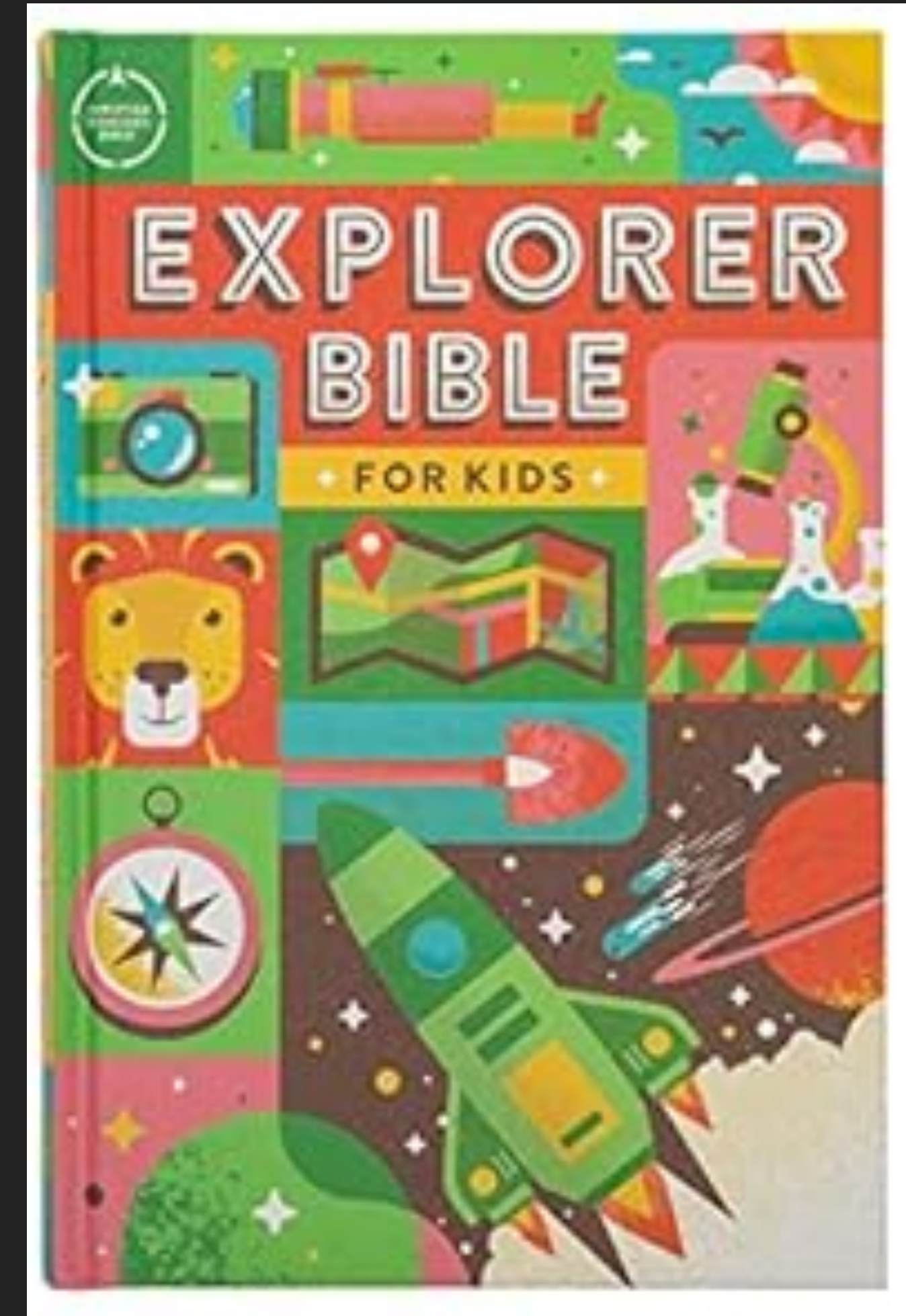

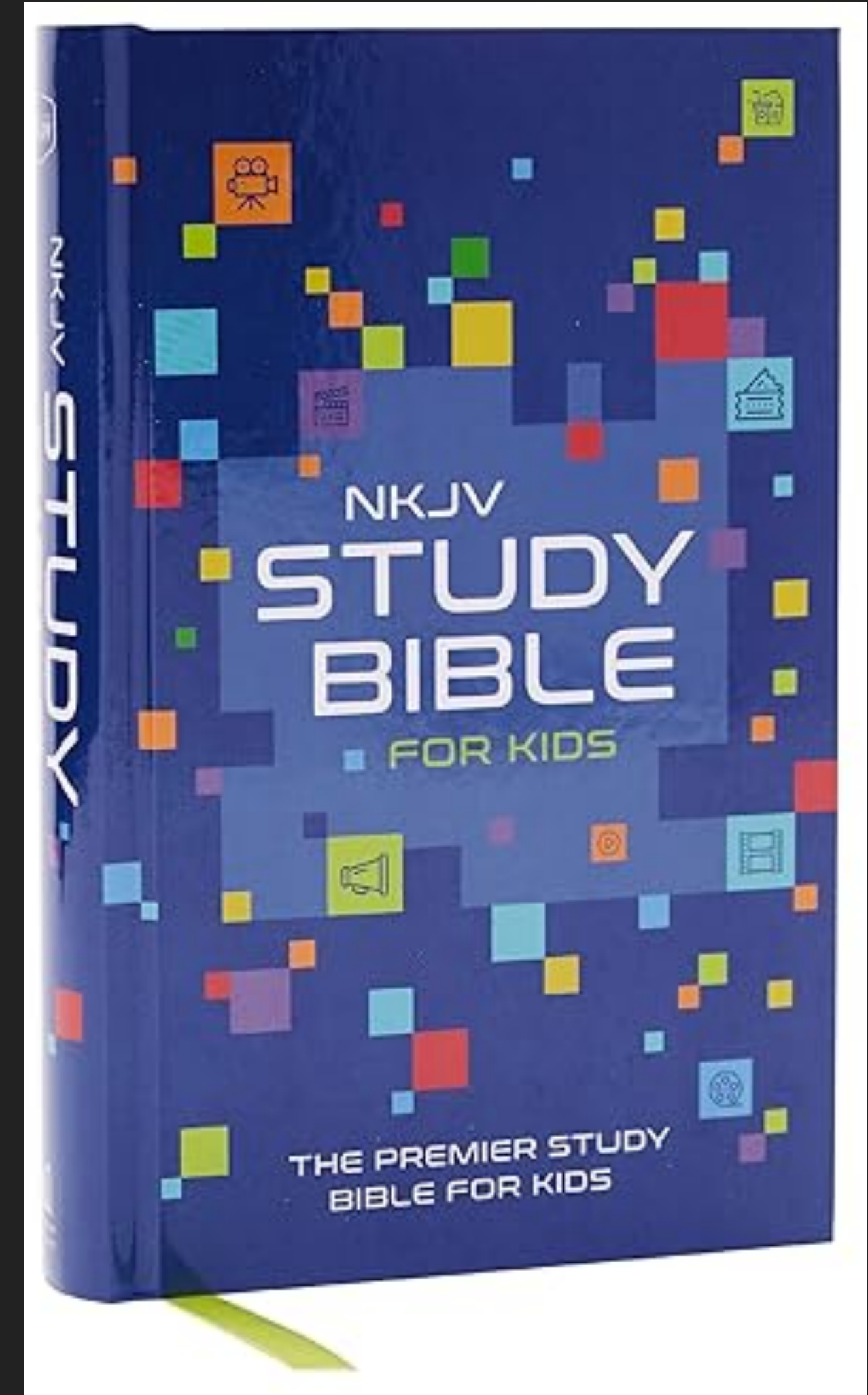

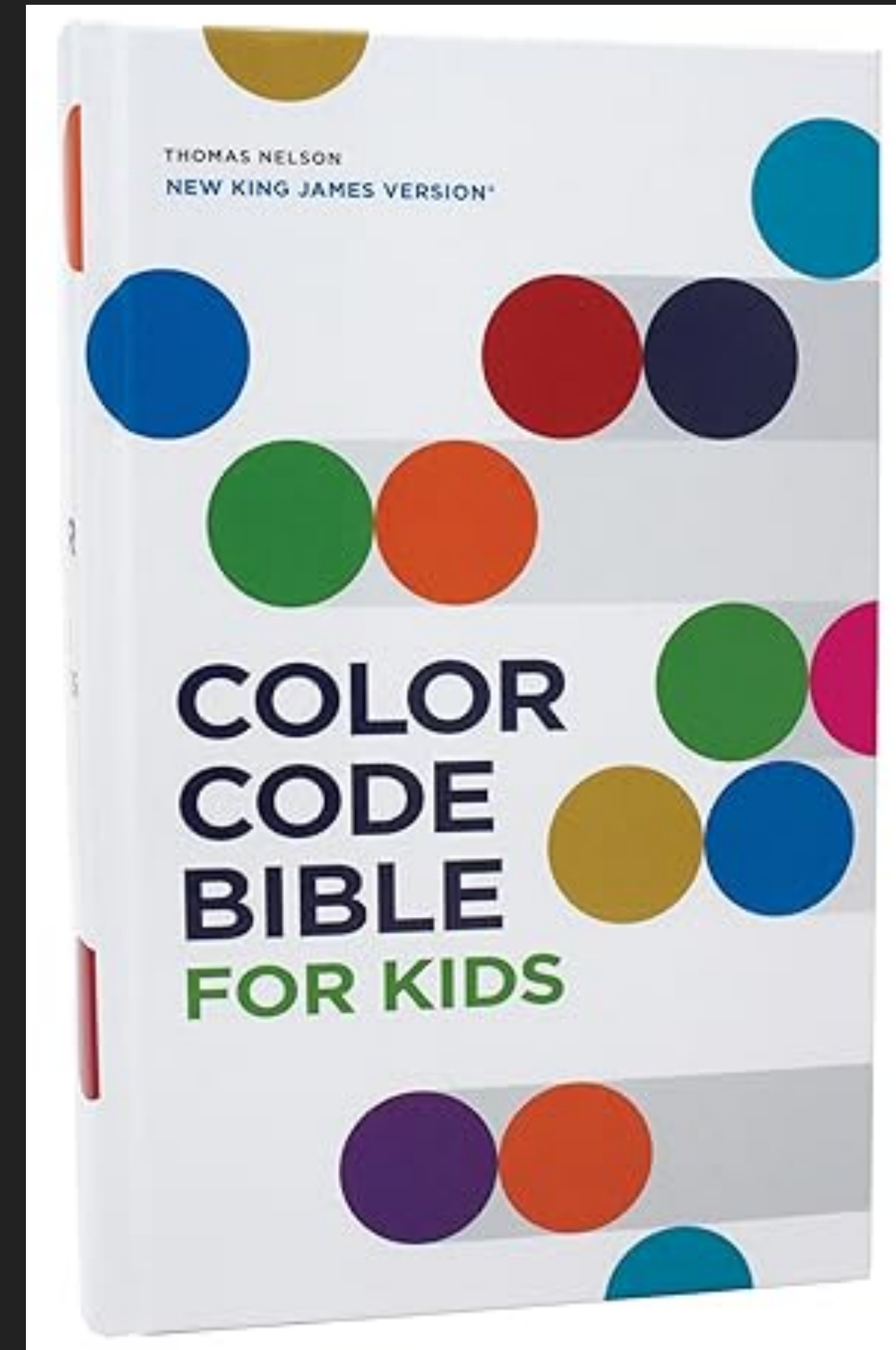
NKJV STUDY BIBLE FOR KIDS
